As a healthy school we encourage children to make healthy choices. If you would like your child to have a snack at break time you may provide a piece of fruit or you may purchase a piece from school for 25p. We also encourage children to drink water throughout the day so they may bring their own water bottle labelled with their name.

Reading is so important even at this young age. Enjoying story time together at home will assist your child with reading, writing and communicating with others. When your child is ready they will bring home a reading book and diary. This book may be a picture book with no words, we encourage you to sit and talk about the pictures and what is happening so your child can tell the story. If you need any assistance with supporting your child with their reading development please let us know.

We use a programme called 'Letters and Sounds', this helps your child learn to read and write fluently. This programme is used throughout the school and children move to their group. More information regarding 'Letters and Sounds' can be given if you wish and we also run parent workshops in school if you would like to learn more.

In Mes Bach we like to be active in our play and learning. We use the outdoor environment as much as possible and we also like to explore and create new things. Please ensure your child has appropriate and suitable footwear. We have some wellies in school that your child may



borrow or you can bring your own. Please label these.

Accidents happen, it can be helpful to have a spare change of clothes in case this happens. We do have some changes of underwear in school but we cannot guarantee the correct size. We do encourage you to avoid sending your child in nappies if at all possible when starting nursery and we can support you in this.

If your child has asthma please ensure they have an inhaler that can be left in school. If your child has any medical needs please ensure their admission form has the information. If your child requires medication throughout the day such as antibiotics, a medication form must be filled in and medication left with our admin officer or teacher.

It can sometimes be an anxious time when your child starts school, but we want to assure you that your child will settle into class and enjoy their time here. If there are any concerns or if your child is upset when starting please let us know so we can support you.

Our first topic will focus on getting to know your child and helping them make new friends and settle into their new class.

We will be playing lots of new games, singing songs, exploring the school and developing a variety of skills.
